SEARCH ME AND KNOW MY HEART Living by His word

When I was reading Psalm 139, I noticed various translations labeled this Psalm "God's Perfect Knowledge of Man". As I went through the entirety of the psalm, I would like to give it a different label: "God's complete commitment to man" Read it from that viewpoint and I know vou'll be blessed.

Vs 1 O LORD, You have searched me and <u>known</u>

me. **<4** Searched: It describes a very deep relationship. Two people not holding anything back. **To Penetrate:** Examine fully, to search by permission. Gal.4:9; 1 Cor.8:3

Vs 2 You know my <u>sitting down</u> and my <u>rising up</u>; You understand my <u>thoughts afar</u> off. ◄ Sitting Down: Weaknesses that stop me. Rising Up: My strengths that move me. Understand: Why I choose my direction. Thoughts Afar Off: The choices I will make before I do.

Vs 3 You <u>comprehend</u> my path and <u>my lying</u> <u>down</u>, And are <u>acquainted</u> with all my ways. ◀◀ **Comprehend:** You scrutinize the direction I would take. **My lying down:** The path I would not take. **Acquainted:** How I will act in a certain way for usefulness or loss.

Vs 4 For there is <u>not a word on my tongue</u>, But behold, O LORD, You know it <u>altogether</u>. ◄◀ Not a word on my tongue: You know what I will say before I do. Altogether: Every aspect.

Vs 5 You have <u>hedged me behind and before</u>, And <u>laid Your hand upon me</u>. **⊲ Hedged me behind and before:** Constructing a protective barrier. Laid Your hand upon me: Called me to service.

Vs6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; 💈

It is high, <u>I cannot attain it</u>. ◄ ◀ I cannot attain it: Impossible to know without Him.

No Matter Where I Go

Vs 7 Where can I go from <u>Your Spirit</u>? Or where can I flee from <u>Your presence</u>? **⊲ ⊲ Spirit -Presence:** He is everywhere in your life.

Vs 8 If I <u>ascend into heaven</u>, <u>You are there</u>; If I <u>make my bed in hell</u>, behold, <u>You are there</u>. ◀◀ Ascend into heaven: In fellowship. Make my bed in hell: out of fellowship. You are there: No matter where I go, even to the extreme corners of the earth

Vs 9 If I take <u>the wings</u> of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, **⊲ The wings:** if I take flight to the uttermost parts of the earth

Vs 10 Even there <u>Your hand</u> shall <u>lead</u> me, And <u>Your right</u> hand shall hold me. **◄** Your hand; lead; Right hand: Your always there to secure and guide me in what You called me to

Times of Distress

Vs 11 If I say, "Surely the <u>darkness</u> shall <u>fall</u> on me, even the night shall be <u>light about me</u>;

Vs 12 Indeed, the <u>darkness</u> shall not <u>hide</u> from You, But the <u>night shines</u> as the <u>day</u>; The <u>darkness</u> and the <u>light</u> are both <u>alike</u> to You. ◀◀ Times of Distress: Depression, bewilderment. When I can't see where I'm going it doesn't stop You from giving me direction or insight.

The Value of Man, An Eternal Being

Vs 13 For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb.

Vs 14 I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well.

Vs 15 My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.

Vs 16 Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, The days <u>fashioned</u> for me, When as yet there were none of them. ⊲⊲ Fashioned:

Formed me as your servant. The value of mankind, he is an eternal being!

How Mindful He Is

Vs 17 How precious also are Your <u>thoughts</u> to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! ◄ Thoughts to me: Very personable; He is so mindful of us..like a dream!

Vs 18 If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand; <u>When I awake</u>, I am still with You. ◀◀ If I should count them: Eternal existent **When I awake:** But in reality it's true.

Looking Into the Heart of Their Choices

Vs 19 Oh, that You would slay the wicked, O God! Depart from me, therefore, you bloodthirsty men.

Vs 20 For they speak against You wickedly; Your enemies take Your name in vain.

Vs 21 Do I not hate them, O LORD, who hate You? And do I not loathe those who rise up against You?

Vs 22 I hate them with <u>perfect hatred</u>; I count them my enemies. **∢ 1 Pet.4:4** He hates the sin, the choices they make that consumes them, which causes them to oppose God until the day they die. This is the position he took with them, because of God in his life.

David's Key to Success

Vs 23 <u>Search</u> me, O God, and <u>know</u> my heart; <u>Try</u> me, and know my <u>anxieties</u>, **⊲< Search**: to penetrate, to examine intimately. **Know**: to perceive, understand, acquire knowledge. **Try**: to examine for purification, results in sanctification. **Anxieties**: A disquieting thought, be troubling

Vs 24 And see if there is any wicked way in me, And <u>lead</u> me in the way <u>everlasting</u>. ◄ Lead: Guide, shows you how and where to walk. Everlasting: To live a way without end. Happy New Year!
