1. Spiritually dead
2. Servants only
3. Accounted righteous
4. Served in types & shadows
5. Served Him as God only
6. Served Him through their flesh
7. God established covenants to preserve them - Hebrews 8
8. Angels served the purpose of God (ministry of angels changed - Hebrews 1)
9. Ministry of death
10. Their sin only covered daily
11. Glory of God manifested in sense realm
12. Served under law
13. Served through a worldly tabernacle
14. Incapable of being brought to perfection - Hebrews 7 & 11
15. Holy Spirit came upon them
16. They received the Word through prophets
17. They had no spiritual language
18. Appointed priest for service
