1. Complacency begins to set in, it stops the process of the salvation of the soul. Hebrews 10:39
2. We begin to cease committing our ways unto the Lord: picking up old habits. 2 Pt 1:9-15 Our mouths and actions begin to revert back to old ways. Heb 10:35
3. Attitudes change, so any type of learning becomes impaired through; fear, depression and being easily offended. Heb 6:19
4. Our ability to correct things is void of spiritual authority. This is because distractions can cause us to stop applying the word of God to life's situations. We are carrying the load through natural means only. 2 Pt 1:4
5. We become full of excuses; blaming our faults on the problems of others. It then becomes easy to stop committing things in prayer. James 1:2-7
6. We are unable to maintain spiritual vision, vacillating in the daily Christian walk; one day in fellowship, the next day out again.
7. A slow process of breaking fellowship with the church; the body of Christ sets in. Since we need each other, it is dangerous when there is no longer a desire to be a functioning member of the local church.
8. If we become overly critical of those around us, it shows potential signs of authority problems; continually seeing the mistakes of others.
